Women in the Community at Qumran – New Perspectives

Women at Qumran? Professor Chazon will discuss the old and new perspectives, the revolution in Scrolls' studies beginning in the 1990's, the Hebrew University's key role, and the current state of the question and of Qumran studies, including the latest data and state of the art digital tools.
